

**Tarantino: Chromatic 2**  
**Assignment for Week 2**  
**(due Wednesday)**

Analyze the first movement of the Sonata, no. 37 in D major: Hob.XVI.37 by Haydn. It is a pretty standard sonata movement.

Mark up the score and be sure to identify the following:

- 1) Location of Exposition, Development and Recapitulation
- 2) In Exposition / Recapitulation identify
  - a. Themes
  - b. Cadences
  - c. Keys of themes
  - d. Transitional Passages
  - e. Modulations
- 3) In Development identify
  - a. Source of melodic material (i.e. second half of Theme 1)
    - i. Identify figuration/arpeggiation as “figuration” or “arpeggiation”
  - b. Far-off Point – the moment before the “retransition” – i.e. how far out harmonically does it get before returning to the tonic.

Renotate the harmonies (in four parts with proper voice leading, measure for measure) for:

- 1) measures 22-35
  - a. What's up with the Bb chord?
- 2) measures 46-61
  - a. Note the use of fourth-species counterpoint
