 - c. Cm: $i \rightarrow III+ \rightarrow V65 \rightarrow iv$
 - d. Fm: $i \rightarrow iv6 \rightarrow ii6 \rightarrow VI \rightarrow V43 \rightarrow I$
- 2) Rhythmicize and expand the following figures using nonharmonic tones

- 3) Assume the following Minuet for Strings (Haydn: Divertimento a Sei, Hob. II: II "Der Geburtstag") is a piano concerto. Write the orchestral string parts. (Violin 1, Violin 2, Viola, Cello, Bass) They should play only the harmonies implied and use proper voice-leading techniques.

I recommend determining the harmonies first (as triads), then connecting those triads in four parts, then assigning the four parts to Violin 1 / Violin 2 / Viola and Cello. Traditionally in music of this era, the Bass doubles the Cello line.
